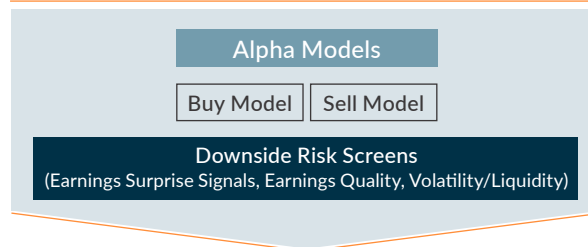

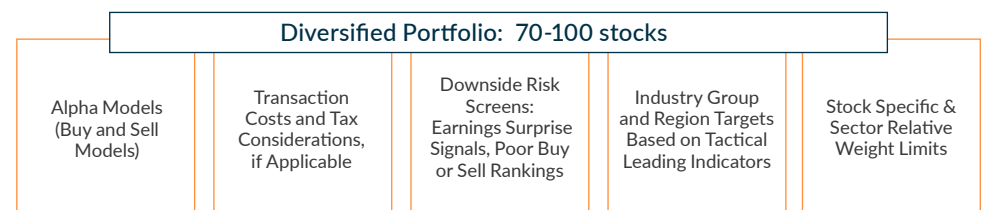


Portfolio Positioning
