

Return on Equity (ROE): net income divided by equity. 5-Year EPS Growth: annualized historical earnings per share growth over the last 5 years. Sharpe Ratio: sharpe ratio is a simple measurement of the risk-adjusted performance. Tracking Error: measures the active risk of the portfolio and the annualized standard deviation of the excess returns between the portfolio and its benchmark. Standard Deviation: measures dispersion of a set of data from its mean. Beta: systematic risk of a portfolio; represents sensitivity to the benchmark. The Russell 1000 Value Index is a total return index with dividends reinvested. It is an unmanaged, market value weighted index, which measures the performance of the 1,000 largest companies in the Russell 3000 Index with lower price-to-book ratios and lower forecasted growth values.
