

Excess Return: amount that returns exceed relative benchmark return. Weighted Average Market Cap: total value of all outstanding shares weighted to reflect the portfolio's positions. Price to Earnings (P/E): ratio of stock price to earnings. Price to Book (P/B): ratio of stock price to per share shareholders' equity. Return on Equity (ROE): net income divided by equity. 3-Year EPS Growth: annualized historical earnings per share growth over the last 3 years. EPS Growth is not a forecast of the fund's future performance. Active Share: measures the percentage of stock holdings in a manager's portfolio that differs from the benchmark index. Sharpe Ratio: sharpe ratio is a simple measurement of the risk-adjusted performance. Tracking Error: measures the active risk of the portfolio and the annualized standard deviation of the excess returns between the portfolio and its benchmark. Standard Deviation: measures dispersion of a set of data from its mean. Beta: systematic risk of a portfolio; represents sensitivity to the benchmark. The S&P 500 Index is a broad based unmanaged index of 500 stocks, which is widely recognized as representative of the equity market in general. One cannot invest directly in an index.
