

Return on Equity (ROE): net income divided by equity. 5-Year EPS Growth: annualized historical earnings per share growth over the last 5 years. EPS Growth is not a forecast of the fund's future performance. Active Share: measures the percentage of stock holdings in a manager's portfolio that differs from the benchmark index. Sharpe Ratio: sharpe ratio is a simple measurement of the risk-adjusted performance. Tracking Error: measures the active risk of the portfolio and the annualized standard deviation of the excess returns between the portfolio and its benchmark. Standard Deviation: measures dispersion of a set of data from its mean. Beta: systematic risk of a portfolio; represents sensitivity to the benchmark. The Russell 1000 Index is an unmanaged, market-capitalization-weighted total return index comprised of the largest 1,000 companies in the Russell 3000 Index.
