

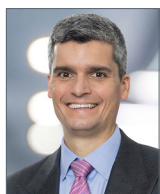

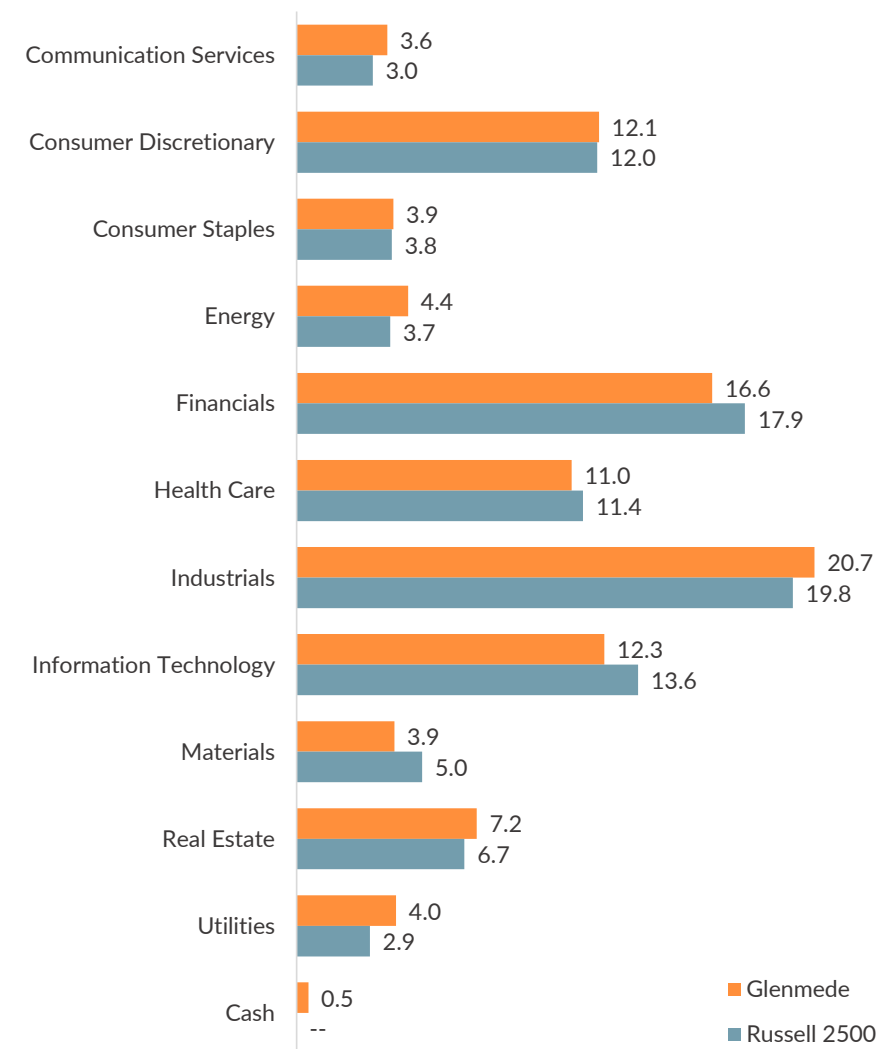

All 2,500 of the companies included in the Index cover the small- and mid-cap market capitalizations. This unmanaged Index is a total return index with dividends reinvested.
